

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

IEEE Turkiye Section,

and

Turkish Electronics Manufacturers Association (TESİD)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into as of December 23, 2023 between IEEE Turkiye Section, and Turkish Electronics Manufacturers Association (TESİD) (hereinafter each of the above-mentioned Sections is referred to as a “Party” or collectively as “Parties”) to establish a framework for intersectional cooperation for achieving the IEEE's and TESİD's core purpose of fostering technological innovation and excellence for the benefit of humanity as set out below.

The Parties

RECOGNIZING the desire to make IEEE and TESİD essential to the global and local technical community and to technical professionals everywhere;

CONSIDERING the need to universally and locally recognize IEEE and TESİD for the contributions of technology and of technical professionals in improving global and local conditions;

EMPHASIZING the Parties' mutual interest in serving their respective members by engaging in different bilateral/multilateral activities;

RECOGNIZING also that the exchange of ideas and expertise in matters of mutual interest creates synergies that are essential in achieving the IEEE's and TESİD's core purpose and are also beneficial to Parties; decide to establish a framework for cooperation as set out below.

ARTICLE I: SCOPE

This MoU establishes a framework to facilitate collaboration between the Parties in a mutually beneficial manner and covers the following modes of bilateral or multilateral cooperation:

- 1.1 Organizing joint conferences, workshops, seminars, etc., on a regular basis.
- 1.2 Performing joint projects and undertaking joint studies.
- 1.3 Inviting scholars, researchers, and experts.
- 1.4 Other types of activity that may be agreed upon by the respective Parties on a case-by-case basis.

The Parties shall on an annual basis define other areas of cooperation and specific activities that would be undertaken for implementing this MoU for the forthcoming year.

ARTICLE II: GENERAL TERMS

2.1 The Parties shall jointly or individually approach IEEE for receiving the necessary support to implement this MoU.

2.2 This MoU does not create any agency, company, joint venture or any other business relationship between the Parties.

2.5 Each Party will introduce an authorized representative and contact point to coordinate various actions during the implementation of this MOU with a view to facilitating and streamlining various activities.

2.6 Each Party undertakes to inform other members of major events, initiatives, and other information of interest to ensure the currency and value of the relationship instigated through this memorandum.

ARTICLE III: DURATION

This MoU is valid for a period of four years from the last signature date and will be automatically renewed for subsequent four-year periods unless modified by mutual written consent of Parties or terminated by any Party with a six-month prior written notice.
